

The Bellagio Theatre is part of the casinohotel of the same name, the most romantic and luxurious in Las Vegas. The theatre, designed for Cirque du Soleils aquatic show O, is absolutely unique, from its baroque-inspired architecture, to its aquatic stage and dragonfly-wing cupola.

The stage is a deep pool equipped with 5 hydraulic elevators that allow it to be modified



from a conventional stage to a 1.4 million gallon pool. The immense metallic trellis of the cupola roof permits infinite lighting possibilities. A large opening in the centre of the cupola makes it possible to present acrobatics directly over the heads of the audience.



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
